

Town Hall Meeting
April 13th, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council hosted a Town Hall Meeting at 7:00 pm at the Mitchellville Community Center, 120 2nd St NE, pursuant to notice.

Council Member McGhee called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Crook, Zook and Engler. Absent: Thomas and Mayor Filbert.

Tree Board Representative Ken Thomas reported that the Tree Board would like to save all the trees and fix the sidewalks. Thomas submitted a bid for treating 19 of the 21 trees on Center Ave from the alley beside City Hall to the bank. The bid was from Bob Lenc Landscaping. Treatment would cost \$3,160.68 a year with the trees needing treatment every two years.

Business owner Marty Stevenson questioned treating some of the trees that are destroying the sidewalks that the property owners have to repair/replace.

Thoughts and/or recommendations from the public: we like the shade, might be in the best interest to remove the bad ones right away and the others as needed, the trees that are removed should be replaced with a variety of trees, treat the ones that can be treated, removing the trees may hurt the Thomas Mitchell Days car show, replace some of the trees with bushes or hanging planters that wouldn't damage the sidewalks.

Council Member McGhee called for adjournment of the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
