

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
April 20, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Filbert called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Crook, Zook and Engler. Absent: Thomas.

Motion made by Engler, second by Zook, to approve the tentative agenda. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Crook to approve the consent agenda approving paying partial payment #3 of \$167,724.75 to Visu-Sewer Inc on Sewer Rehab Project, paying claims of \$237,526.04, 4/6/15 Council Minutes (as amended to include "Then the council decided to look at recommendations from" at the beginning of the 3rd sentence in paragraph 6, 4/13/15 Town Hall Minutes, and accepting David Keicher's resignation from the Planning & Zoning Commission. Motion carried unanimous.

Public Audience: Marty Stephenson, 213 Carter St NW, discussed the damage to the sidewalk in front of his business, Team 36, and was disappointed that it wasn't on the agenda for tonight's meeting.

Public Audience: Jackie Stephenson, Team 36, 101 2nd St NW discussed a water pressure problem.

Public Audience: Don Berkey, 113 2nd St NW supports the Tree Board recommendation of treating the trees.

Public Audience: Ed Brose, 307 2nd St NW spoke about the potholes and chunks of asphalt on Cotton Ave.

Byron Johnston, 306 4th St NE gave an update on the progress for this year's Habitat for Humanity project, which is scheduled for June 19th & 20th.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Crook, to approve request from Concrete Technologies, Inc. for permission to erect and operate a concrete batch plant on E 62nd Ave (Stan Webb's land) near Mitchellville. This site is a back-up option for them and may not be needed. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by Crook, second by McGhee to approve Resolution 2015-22 increasing city hall petty cash account from \$75 to \$100. Motion carried unanimous.

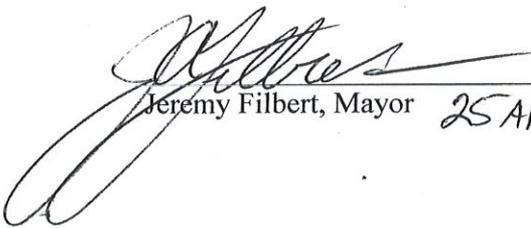

Motion made by Engler, second by McGhee to allow the Tree Board to accept a bid of their choosing, and with funds they have raised themselves, to treat the trees along Center Avenue. Motion carried unanimous.

Department Heads and Council Members gave updates.

Mayor Filbert stated his intention to resign, effective April 30, 2015.

Mayor Filbert called for adjournment of the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
