

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings  
Regular Meeting – April 4, 2016

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave N, pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Crook, and Sanger.

Absent: Mitchell and Zook.

Mayor Woods requested an amendment to the tentative agenda, removing item 6 Representative Zack Nunn giving legislative updates.

A motion by Sanger to approve the amended tentative agenda, seconded by Crook. Motion carried.

A motion by Crook to approve the consent agenda, which approved payments of bills of \$117,217.59, includes 1 regular payroll, 3-21-16 Council minutes, Library Board of Trustees 2-22-16 meeting minutes, Feb. Library monthly stats, March Bills and March Library Director's report, seconded by Sanger. Motion carried.

Public Audience: None.

Jim Lockwood from Diamond Crystal Brands, 215 Mill St. SW, informed the Council that Hormel Foods was selling Diamond Crystal Brands and wanted confirmation from the City Council that there was no objection to their current use of a portion of the right-of-way on Mill Street. This area is used for 2 parking lots and driveway access to its facility. A motion by McGhee to provide a letter from the City stating its agreement to the continue use by Diamond Crystal Brands, seconded by Sanger. Motion carried.

Council member Zook arrived at 7:13 pm.

Representative Leslie Irlbeck from Metro Waste gave the Council a presentation on co-mingling of yard and garbage at Metro Park East Landfill. The Metro Waste staff is presenting this topic to all surrounding area council members to ensure the yard waste policy is set after taking all feedback into consideration. The Metro Waste Board will be voting on this policy in June or July of this year.

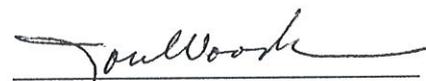
