

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting, August 15, 2016 Minutes

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City hall, 204 Center Ave N, pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: Crook, McGhee, Zook, Mitchell and Sanger. Motion made by Crook, second by Mitchell to approve tentative agenda. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by Crook, second by Zook, to approve the consent agenda, which approved payment of bills of \$88,782.64, including 1 regular payroll, and August 1, 2016 Council minutes. Motion carried unanimous.

Public Audience: Sandra Allgood, 114 3rd St NW, shared her concerns about her neighbor using a gas fogger that is very toxic to birds, bees, fish, humans, and other animals.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Crook, to change the date of the first City Council meeting in September from Monday, September 5th to Tuesday, September 6th, due to Labor Day. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, Second by Crook, to consider for approval the second reading of Ordinance 2121, Amending City Code Chapter 46 Minors. Ayes: Mitchell, McGhee, Crook. Nays: Zook and Sanger. Motion Carried.

Amerist Chambers, 103 4th St NW, gave an update on the plans for Thomas Mitchell Days 2016.

City Administrator Crocker received the go ahead from Council to start a city facebook page. The page would serve as a communication tool and he would monitor it.

Updates were given by Department Heads, Council Members, and Mayor. McGhee reported that he attended a P&Z meeting, in which the zoning change request was denied. Crook shared that he has received some information about Arbor Day and trees and will share with the Tree Board at their next meeting. Mayor Woods reported that he attended a Dart Meeting and a MAC Meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 7:15 pm.


