

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
August 17th, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Crook, Thomas, Zook and Engler.

Motion made by Thomas, second by Zook, to approve the tentative agenda. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Zook to approve the consent agenda paying claims of \$96,832.42, 8/3/15 Council Minutes, and renewal of Casey's General Store #2177 liquor license. Motion carried unanimous.

Richard Cooper, 702 Neely St NE, requested to be on the agenda to discuss putting up speed limit signs on Neely St NE in Deer Run. Richard Cooper was not in attendance.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Engler, to approve Resolution 2015-43, dismissal of certain unpaid utility bills under \$20. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Thomas to approve Resolution 2015-44, a pay increase for Paul Green for receiving his Grade 1 Drinking Water Distribution certifications. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by Thomas, second by McGhee, to approve Resolution 2015-45, changing the date for the first City Council meeting in September to Tuesday, September 1st, 2015. Motion carried unanimous.


Motion made by Crook, second by Zook, to implement the new Website Policy. Motion carried unanimous.

Council discussed the park hours as listed in Ordinance Chapter 47.05. City Administrator was tasked with presenting an amended Ordinance for the Council to consider at the next meeting. Changes are to include – setting park hours as sunrise to sunset, excluding the baseball fields, and allowing for exemptions if shelter house is rented past sunset.

Department Heads and Council Members gave updates. Mayor Woods announced the Lions Club newest "Yard of the Month" winner was Marie Miller, 310 Center Ave S. Mayor Woods reported he participated in the presentation of the Chambers' Awards at Thomas Mitchell Days. Snyder Landscaping received the Business of the Year Award. Jim Appleget was awarded as the Volunteer of the Year. Dave Wieslander was honored with the Citizen of the Year award.


Public Audience: None
