

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting – August 3, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Engler, Crook, and Zook.
Absent: Thomas

A motion by Crook to approved the tentative agenda, second by Engler. Motion carried.

A motion by Engler to approve the consent agenda, approving payments of \$64,870.64 includes 1 regular payroll and the 7-20-2015 council minutes. Library June 2015 meeting minutes and stats, July 2015 Director's report and bill. Motion carried.

Public Audience: None

Representative Zach Nunn provided legislative updates on bills that passed and those that didn't.

A motion by McGhee to approve the P&Z Commission's recommendation for approval of the building permits request by Casey's General Store for a 600 square foot addition to their building at 309 Center Ave. S, second by Zook. Motion carried.

A motion by McGhee to approve resolution 2015-38 transferring \$10,336.36 excess 2015 year end Fire Dept. funds into the EMS and Fire replacement funds, second by Zook. Motion carried.

A motion by McGhee to approve resolution 2015-39, creating a Police Car replacement fund, and the transfer of \$4,000.00 General funds to the Police Care Replacement fund, second by Engler. Motion carried.

A motion by McGhee to approve resolution 2015-40 transferring \$25,371.12 excess 2015 year end Police Dept. funds into the Police Car replacement fund, second by Engler. Motion carried.

A motion by McGhee to approve resolution 2015-41 transferring \$13,862.59 from the Sewer Fund to Sewer Sinking fund for 2015 SRF loan payment, second by Crook. Motion carried.

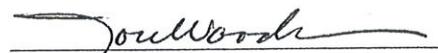
A motion by McGhee to approve resolution 2015-42 transferring \$9,075.00 from the Water Fund to the Debit Service fund for loan interest payment, second by Crook. Motion carried.

Clerk Rahni Brose explained the Iowa Income Offset Program and the City's participation in the program to collect on unpaid utility bills. A motion by Engler to allow her to write off unpaid uncollectable utility bills over 5 years old and unpaid bill of \$20.00 or less over 1 year old, second by Crook. Motion carried.

Mayor Woods updated the council on the meeting with Supervisor Van Oort and Bob Rice on the City possibly obtaining a loan for the asphaltting of previously selected streets. After some discussion, a motion by McGhee to forgo the loan and asphalt some streets each year while continuing to maintain others, second by Zook. Motion carried.

Updates were given by Department Heads, Council Members and Mayor.

Mayor Woods called for adjournment, motion by Crook, second by Engler, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
