

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting – December 21, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Engler, Crook, Thomas and Zook.

A motion by Thomas to approved the tentative agenda, second by Zook. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Engler to approve the consent agenda, approving payments of \$111,102.36 includes 1 regular payroll and the 12-7-2015 council minutes, second by Crook. Motion carried unanimous.

Public Audience: None

Ted Olson, 208 3rd St, informed the council that every year Facebook awards grants to towns in the Southeast Polk school district. On behave the Community Center board he applied for an approximate \$13,000 grant that would allow four of the City departments and the Community Center to have a single central internet and Wi-Fi connection. He felt this would allow better public access to these services and a possible savings for the City and Community Center. He requested the council put in a line item for \$3,000 to \$5,000 in the budget for future expenses on this possible project.

A motion by Thomas to approve the third reading of Ordinance # 2117, amending the Mitchellville Zoning Ordinance by adding a Core District to the R1-R5 zoning codes and amending M1-M2 zoning codes allowing for more permitted uses, second by McGhee. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by McGhee to approve Resolution 2015-52 approving the City Financial Audit for the year ending 6-30-2015, second by Crook. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Engler approving partial payment number 6 for the 2014 CDBG Sewer Rehabilitation project, second by Thomas. Motion carried unanimous.



Updates were given by department heads, council member and the mayor with each person thanking Laura Engler and Deb Thomas for their service.


Public Audience: None
