

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting, July 18th, 2016 Minutes

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City hall, 204 Center Ave N, pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Zook, Mitchell, Crook, and Sanger. Motion made by Crook, second by Mitchell to approve tentative agenda. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion by Zook, second by McGhee, to approve the consent agenda, which approved payment of bills of \$73,587.00, including 1 regular payroll, July 5th, 2016 Regular Council Minutes, approving Edward Wieslander's appointment to the Park & Rec Commission, and approving appointment of Greg Crocker as Alternate for MPO..

Motion made by McGhee, second by Sanger to approve Resolution 2016-47 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from Emergency Fund to General Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by Zook, second by McGhee to approve Resolution 2016-48 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from Cemetery Perpetual Care Fund to General Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Mitchell to approve Resolution 2016-49 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from Special Assessment Fund to General Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Sanger to approve Resolution 2016-50 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from General Fund to Fire Truck Replacement Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Crook to approve Resolution 2016-51 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from General Fund to Police Car Replacement Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Sanger to approve Resolution 2016-52 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from Water and Sewer Funds to Public Works Equipment Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Zook to approve Resolution 2016-53 Transferring Funds for Fiscal Year 2016 from General Fund to Fire Equipment Fund. Motion carried unanimous.

Motion made by McGhee, second by Crook, to approve Ordinance 2121, an ordinance amending City Code of Ordinance Chapter 46 Minors. Chief Kary spoke about modeling our ordinance after other cities, which would tidy it up. Zook questioned the removal of most of the exceptions regarding civil

liberties or emergency situations. Sanger stated that it wasn't a current issue as there have been no curfew tickets issued. Ayes: McGhee, Mitchell, Crook. Nays: Zook and Sanger. Motion carried.

Updates were given by Department Heads, Council Members, and Mayor. Chief Twohey reported that the fire department is updating for changes in medicare. Karen shared the library has new outside benches and tables that are being utilized. Chief Kinmonth reported that the new squad car was in service. Crook shared concerns about city employees discussing other departments with non-city employees. Zook said that Little League will start working on the ballfields. Sanger stated that the city is starting the process to take action against nuisance properties. Sanger also shared concerns about city employees and officials using facebook to try to influence the council. Mayor Woods welcomed Greg Crocker as the new City Administrator. Woods stated that our code of conduct spells it out pretty clearly on public officials airing city business on social media. Woods will be attending MWA and Dart meetings. Greg attended a meeting on Municipal Law and will meet with Alex Lynch with East Polk Regional Development on Tuesday. Greg will schedule a work session for the Council with Jeff Schott from the University of Iowa for council training and goal setting
