

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting – March 16, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Filbert called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Crook, Thomas, Zook and Engler.

A motion by Thomas to approved the tentative agenda, second by Zook. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Engler to approve the consent agenda approving partial payment of \$144,528.06 to Visu-Sewer, Inc. on the Sewer Rehab Project, paying claims of \$224,895.51 includes 1 regular payroll, and the 3-2-15 council minutes, second by McGhee. Motion carried unanimous.

Public Audience: Jon Woods, 204 3rd St. NE, stated he was disappointed to hear the 1976 Dodge truck had been sold without it going out for bids. He had a couple friends who would have liked to bid on it.

Mayor Filbert read the proclamation declaring April 13th – 18th as Affordable Housing Week.

The City received 5 cemetery mowing bids. The bids were opened and reviewed by the council. Council member Engler requested Public Works Director Patterson to review the bids and make a recommendation to the council. A motion by McGhee to table awarding of the mowing bids until the April 6, 2015 meeting, second by Zook. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Thomas to approve Jeremy Egley's application to the Mitchellville Fire Dept., second by Crook. Motion carried unanimous.

After some discussion, a motion by McGhee for the City to decline the right to civil prosecution for the recent tobacco retailer sales to a minor in Mitchellville, second by Zook. Motion carried unanimous.

Engler submitted an application for the P&Z Commission and an application for the City Tree Board. Currently there are no openings on the Tree Board. Mayor Filbert will look at the current members and their attendance at the meetings. A motion by McGhee to appoint Liz Kennedy to the P&Z Commission, second by Thomas. Motion Carried unanimous.

Department heads, Council members and the Mayor gave updates.

Mayor Filbert adjourned the meeting at 7:40 pm.
