

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings  
Regular Meeting – October 20, 2014

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Filbert called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Crook, Thomas, Zook and Engler.

A motion by Engler to amend the tentative agenda, changing item number 6 to include the word process, second by Thomas. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Crook to approved the amended tentative agenda, second by Thomas. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Crook to approve the consent agenda paying claims of \$95,409.41 includes 1 regular payroll, the 10-6-14 council minutes, and approves the liquor license for Team 36 Bar & Grill, second by Zook. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Thomas to approve Resolution 2014-47 appointing Laurie Fenimore to the City Tree Board, second by McGhee. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Crook to discuss the annexation process, second by Zook. Ayes: Thomas, McGhee, and Crook. Nays: Engler and Zook.

A motion by McGhee to proceed with the voluntary annexation process for the Craig property NW of the City, second by Thomas. Ayes: Thomas, McGhee and Crook. Nays: Zook and Engler.


A motion by Thomas to change Ordinance 105.5 – Open Burning, no second. Motion failed.

There was a discussion on the few higher utility billings due to the City water discoloration.


Updates from Department Heads, Council Members and the Mayor.

Don Berkey, 113 2<sup>nd</sup> St. NW, asked who made the decision to have only one public audience and he was informed it was the Mayor's decision. He suggested the council overrule that decision. He asked when a permit has to be taken out to make changes on a property and was informed it is before the project begins. It also depends on what changes are being made to determine if there is a need for a permit.
