

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings  
Regular Meeting – September 1, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Thomas, Crook, and Zook. Absent: Engler.

A motion by Thomas to approved the tentative agenda, second by McGhee. Motion carried.

A motion by McGhee to approve the consent agenda, approving payments of \$114,906.69 includes 1 regular payroll and the 8-17-2015 council minutes. Library July 2015 Stats, August 2015 Director's report, bills and Library Treasurer letter on change of financial procedure. Motion carried.

Public Audience: Byron Johnston, 306 4<sup>th</sup> St. NW, gave updates on this year's three Habitat for Humanity City projects. The city received \$11,840 in donations and a little over \$8,000 was used. The committee is looking for next year's projects. Volunteer turnout was good this year and will be NEEDED for next year.

Orland Sivert, Lakeview Mobil Home Park, the road from interstate to 6<sup>th</sup> St. NE is in need of repair again. He suggested it be done this fall.

Ean Richardson, 412 Center Ave. N made a request to the council for his dog to be allowed back in the city limits after the dog bit a person. Mayor Woods explained because the city does have an animal ordinance in place on dog bites, the city could not allow the dog back because the city would be liable if the dog bit someone else. After a brief discussion, Mr. Richardson was told the dog could not be brought back in the city limits.

A motion by McGhee to approval Resolution 2015-46 adopting the Annual Street Finance Report for fiscal year June 30, 2015, second by Crook. Motion carried.

A motion by McGhee to approval Resolution 2015-47 Transfer of funds from General Fund and Library T&A Account to create a new Library General Fund second by Thomas. Motion carried.

A motion by Thomas to approval Resolution 2015-48 a LED Street Lighting Installation Agreement between MidAmerican Energy and The City of Mitchellville, second by McGhee. An amended motion by Thomas approving Resolution 2015-48 using the standard option, second by McGhee. Motion carried.

A motion by Crook to for approval the first reading of Ordinance #2115 replacing the City's Parks Closed Time to Sunset to Sunrise, second by Zook. Motion carried.


A motion by Crook to waive the second reading of Ordinance #2115, second by Zook. Motion carried.

A motion by Crook to waive the third reading of Ordinance #2115, second by Thomas. Motion carried. Ordinance change is enacted.
