

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting – September 21, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N, pursuant to notice.

Mayor Woods called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Thomas, Crook, Zook and Engler.

A motion by Crook to approved the tentative agenda, second by Thomas. Motion carried unanimous.

A motion by Thomas to approve the consent agenda, approving payments of \$295,374.08 includes 1 regular payroll and the 9-1-2015 council minutes, second by McGhee. Discussion, Crook has some questions about the new truck purchased by Public Works. Ayes: Zook, Thomas, McGhee and Engler. Nays: Crook. Motion carried.

Public Audience: Don Berkey, 113 2nd St. NW commented on an agenda item. The tree and sidewalk by the Heritage Word of Life Church, he stated he would expect the church to pay for the repairs.

Omar Padilla, Outreach Coordinator for Habitat summarized the 3 years that Habitat has been helping out in Mitchellville. He was looking to the City to budget a donation to Habitat for the next fiscal year.

Doug Rohrer, 102 2nd St wanted clarification about the tree root damage to the sidewalk in front of Heritage Work of Life Church. He stated they did not want to remove the tree but knew the roots caused the damage to the sidewalk. Mayor Woods informed him our City Attorney advised the city about the liabilities associated with the trees and sidewalks. They are the responsibility of the property owners. Mr. Rohrer was also looking to the council for possible solutions to vehicles parking in front of their van driveway. Mayor Woods said maybe cross painting in front of the driveway. He said for him to work with Public Works and the Police. Engler suggested he post "No Parking Signs" on both sides of the driveway.

Updates were given by department heads and council members. The Mayor reminded department heads he want them to do inventory and update their CIP before the October 5th meeting.


Public Audience: Don Berkey, 113 2nd St. NW requested a big clock to put up on the back wall of the council chambers and he asked "what about Marty's driveway?"
