

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Special Meeting January 16, 2014

The Mitchellville City Council met in special session at 7:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Avenue N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Filbert called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: Thomas, Zook, Crook, McGhee and Engler.

Mayor Filbert explained this was an informal work session to discuss some issues he had been thinking about. The issues were an all-day retreat for the council, update on the grass fire truck replacement, posting for the Public Works Director position, the budget, military vehicles and the emerald ash borer.

Chief Twohey stated his is working directly with the ICAP adjuster on the fire truck replacement.

The all-day work session will be Saturday February 1st in the council chambers at City Hall. Some topics will be the CIP, goal setting for the City and if needed the budget.

Job posting for the Public Works Director should be going out end of January.

As there was no information on the budget, it will be discussed at the January 20th regular meeting.

Mayor Filbert informed the council of the availability of certain military vehicles and little or no cost to cities. The discussion was on how the City could utilize them.

There was some discussion as to the need for the City to review if we have any ash trees and how to handle them.

Mayor Filbert called for adjournment, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
