

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Special Meeting January 24, 2015

The Mitchellville City Council met in special session at 10:06 a.m. in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Avenue N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Filbert called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, Thomas, Zook, Engler and Crook.

CFO Dillavou informed the council that Mayor Filbert has sent her a copy of an email after the January 10th meeting requesting additional general fund expenditures of \$15,056.50. These expenditures were for an additional \$5000.00 in the Mayor and Council line item and \$10,056.50 in Police Salaries increases including the previously approved 3%.

The Council reviewed and did some cuts in the remaining general fund accounts, removed the additional in the Mayor and Council line item and reduced some of the Police's other line items bringing the deficit to \$3,563.94 in the general fund and increasing the tax levy to 14.082. In order to maintain the current tax levy of 13.999 an additional \$4000.00 would need to be cut or a total of \$7,563.94 to approve the Police salaries requested increases.

After some discussion it was decided to have a work session at the February 2nd meeting.

Mayor Filbert adjourned the meeting at 1:06 p.m.
