

Mitchellville City Council Proceedings
Regular Meeting – June 3, 2013

The Mitchellville City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall, 204 Center Ave. N., pursuant to notice.

Mayor Roberts called the meeting to order, roll call, members present: McGhee, D. Thomas, Snyder, K. Thomas and Zook.

A motion by D. Thomas to approve the agenda, second by McGhee. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion by Snyder to approve the consent agenda. Approving claims of \$107,429.01, includes 1 regular payroll and May 20, 2013 council meeting minutes and resolution 2013-28 approved transferring funds from TIF to LMI. Library Board of Trustees April 2013 meeting minutes, May 2013 finance statement and April 2013 statistics. Second by D. Thomas. Motion carried unanimously.

No Public Comments.

Representative Joe Riding gave Legislative updates from the last session.

A motion by McGhee to approve Resolution 2013-25, authorization to Destroy Closed Session Minutes and tape and erase open session tapes over 1 year old. Second by D. Thomas, motion carried unanimously.

A motion by Snyder to approve Resolution 2013-26, 5 year renewal of the 28E agreement with SCCIC. Second by K. Thomas, motion carried unanimously.

A motion by Snyder to approve Resolution 2013-27, continuing support of the StormReady Program guidelines. Second by Zook, motion carried unanimously.

A motion by D. Thomas to approve the third reading of Ordinance 2101 amending Chapter 95 Sanitary Sewer to include An Infiltration & Inflow Policy. Second by K. Thomas ayes: Snyder, D. Thomas, Zook, and K. Thomas Nays: McGhee. Ordinance enacted.

The council discussed a request to the Fire Department to fill swimming pools in the city. A motion by Snyder to reject the request, main reasons not wanting to tie up city resources and possible delay in case of an emergency call. Second by Zook, motion carried unanimously.

The council discussed different options and cost of doing something in memory of Jim Scott. Motion by McGhee to purchase a bench with engraving and approved \$500.00 for the project. Second by D. Thomas, motion carried unanimously.

No Public Comments.

Council members and department gave updates on attended meetings and projects.

Mayor Roberts called for adjournment, all in favor, Meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
